Covid Implications on service to patients

Dr H Stated that the surgery was coping well with the number of patients requiring medical assistance including the most vulnerable patients, in fact we are now seeing more patients face to face than we did before, as well as using video calls and telephone consultations. Some staff have left for less demanding jobs, also there are changes to the number of doctors at the surgery.

The NHS is instructing doctors to get on board with the booster jabs but still carry out their day-to-day work to see patients, the surgery will carry out the booster vaccines in house as required.

Mike stated that his wife had been seen by specialists in hospital and had now been discharged but since leaving hospital she has not had a face-to-face appointment with a doctor to ensure that her medication is correct. He praised Estell for being the most helpful person that they have been dealing with at the present time.

Up Graded phone system

Comments were made by Eddie regarding the phone system and 3 other members also had had problems trying to get through with getting down to number 1 then it says you are in position 2 (system counts back ward?) apparently this has happened to several members.

Janette said the new system was up graded and installed on the 28 July 2021; all staff now trained up on it. There did not seem to be any trouble with it, but staff had

been told to report any problems that patients had mentioned. Janette had not been informed of any in recent weeks. Jannette to investigate these issues.

DA asked whether the CCG changing to an ICS in April will have any effect on the surgery/doctors, Dr H stated that he did not think so.
